## LABFIND PRIVACY STATEMENT

August 27th, 2019

### Intended Use

LabFind provides near-real-time availability information for some technology resources on partner school campuses. LabFind may be used by current students and faculty of those organizations to be matched with and locate those resources. LabFind should not be used to compile or cache information about school resources. It should also not be used in excess to the extent that it affects the availability of the service.

### Collected Data

LabFind collects your email address, through the registration process, for the purpose of verifying your access to LabFind. In addition, certain usage data may be collected for the purpose of understanding how LabFind is used. This information will be used by LabStats to improve LabFind and may also be presented to your school so they may understand the demand for their technology resources.

### GDPR Compliance

In accordance with Section 26 of the GDPR, the data that LabFind collects has been “rendered anonymous in such a manner that the data subject is not or no longer identifiable.” Collected data that undergoes anonymization includes the student’s registration information. Our strenuous anonymization process ensures that all personally identifiable information is automatically anonymized and that deanonymization is not reasonably likely. Therefore, the processing of this information for statistical and research purposes is not of concern under the GDPR.
